Interchurch Families & Christian Unity: *Interchurch Families United in baptism & marriage called to a common life in the church for the reconciliation of our churches*

Reproduced in booklet form, this paper was adopted by the 2nd World Gathering of Interchurch Families from 11 countries held in Rome in July 2003. 18 pages, A5 format. Price £1.00 incl post & packing.

Churches Together in Marriage: Pastoral Care of Interchurch Families

published by Churches Together in England and CYTUN (Churches Together in Wales) and prepared by a working group set up by the Group for Local Unity of CTE. It draws on material supplied by the churches, interchurch families, and professionals concerned with marriage support, containing *guidelines* for local clergy and ministers and *recommendations* for the consideration of church leaders. 1994, 76 pages. Double Belonging: Interchurch Families and Christian Unity

by George Kilcourse, a priest of the Diocese of Louisville, USA, and Professor of Theology at Bellarmine College. It stresses the contribution interchurch families can make to parish renewal and Christian unity, if they are not marginalised by the churches. 188 pages. *Paulist Press/Fowler Wright*, 1992. Two Churches: One Love, by Alasdair Heron, a Church of Scotland minister, explains the Roman Catholic treatment of mixed marriages in the past and the changes since the Second Vatican Council. 84 pages. *APCK Dublin*, 1977. Price £1.00 incl p/p.

Ecumenism for Catholics: the story, the theory, the practice

by William Steele, who has distilled a huge amount of history, presenting it clearly in an accessible form as a useful and thought-provoking introduction to ecumenical relations, ending with a concluding reflection on recent English experience. 25pages. *Blackfriars Publications* 2003. Price £1.50 + 30p p/p.

Sharing Communion: an Appeal to the Churches by Interchurch Families, edited by Ruth Reardon & Melanie Finch, from a survey of Association member couples. Includes all relevant documents on eucharistic sharing, from Vatican II to 1982. 142 pages. *Collins* 1983. Price £1.00 incl p/p.

Whom God Hath Joined, by Mary Bard, based on a survey of Association members, analyses the impact on church life of interchurch families who can be seen, not so much as a problem to their churches, but also a point of strength and cause for rejoicing. 120 pages. *McCrimmons* 1987.
