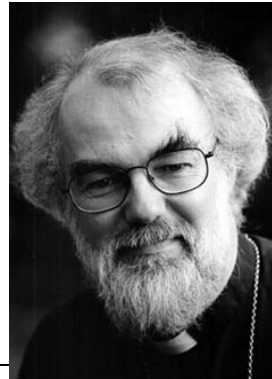

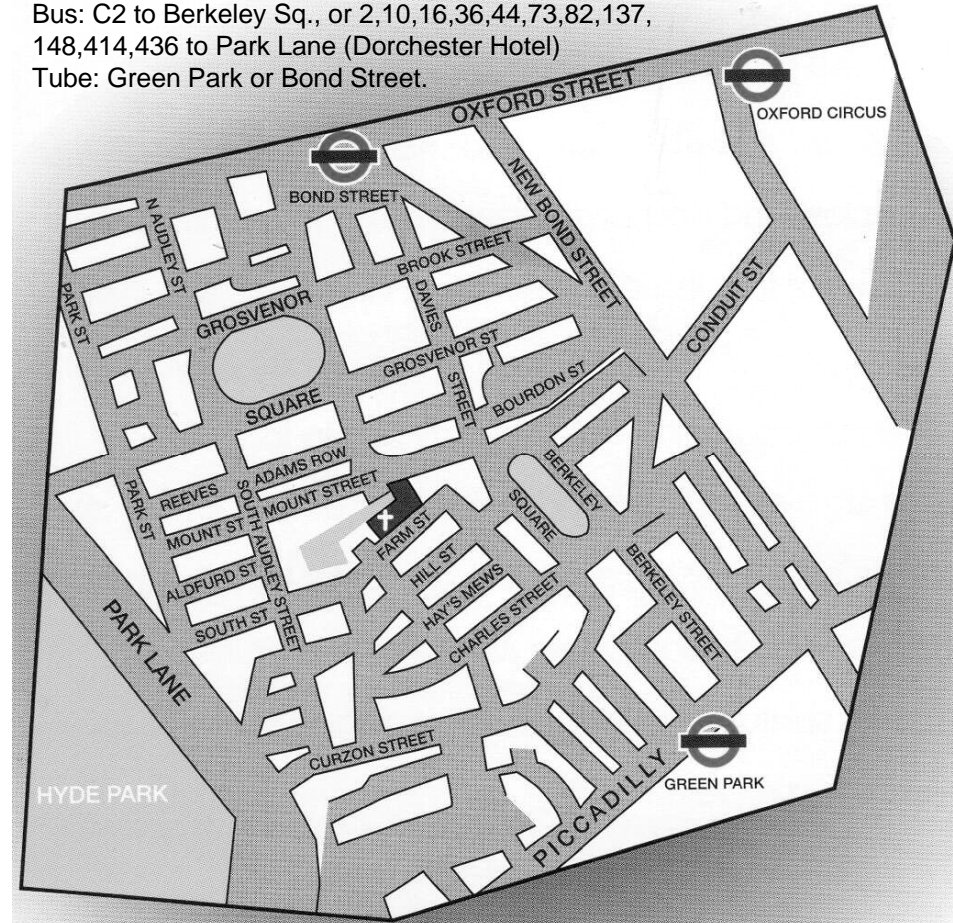

**The Association of Interchurch Families (AIF)** offers a support network for families in which one partner is usually Roman Catholic or Orthodox and the other a Christian of another communion. It gives a voice for such couples and families as they seek to make their pastoral needs known within the churches, as well as making a vital contribution to the growing together of the churches in the cause of Christian unity.

**Fr John Coventry SJ** was a founder of AIF in 1968. He developed a theological understanding of mixed marriages between baptised Christians, and gave pastoral care to hundreds of couples. He served as Co-chair for many years and subsequently as president up to the time of his death in 1998. He referred to interchurch families as “my life’s devotion”. He was a member of the Jesuit Community at Mount Street and his funeral took place in the church at Farm Street.
